## *The First Big Latin-Greek Lexicon: When, Where, and Why?*

It has long been known that large bilingual dictionaries were first created in the sixth century AD; before that, Latin speakers reading Greek texts and Greek speakers reading Latin ones only had small glossaries, often restricted to particular types of vocabulary. The pride of place among the big sixth-century dictionaries was occupied by the Latin-Greek lexicon of ps-Philoxenus, a treasure trove of learned and archaic vocabulary. But now a papyrus fragment of ps-Philoxenus has emerged, and it is datable to c. AD 200. How does that fragment change our understanding of the history of this dictionary and of ancient dictionaries more generally?
